



TROPICAL FOOTPRINTS ART EXHIBITION/AUCTION

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Entries are required to be the original work and concept of the Artist.

Preference will be given to artists not exhibiting in another GTAF exhibition. If space is available, pieces will be selected based on date that the 'Expression of Interest' was received.

All care will be taken when handling art work, but the organisers cannot take responsibility for any damage or theft, therefore, artists are required to insure their work if they so wish.

Expressions of interest can be made immediately by email to elizabethperriam@bigpond.com accompanied by a photograph of your artwork if possible. Deadline for registration is 30 September 2010. As a guideline, artists are invited to submit two pieces of work, neither larger than 1000mm x 1000mm.

By OCTOBER 4 2010 you may send photos of your work by email which may be used for publicity; at least 300 dpi, 1 – 5 mb in size, via email or CD delivered to the Gazette.

Images should also include titles and dimension of your artwork. This can be accompanied by a one page CV to assist with media releases and editorial content. Please use the following email address for this information: gazette@tpd.newsltd.com.au with Subject: Tropical Footprints

Approximately TEN pieces of art will be selected by a qualified panel of artists not involved in the exhibition for AUCTION at a cocktail party to be held on Friday, 29 October 2010.

Artists to provide a invoice attached to their artwork on the 18 October 2010. (Pro-Forma Invoice available upon request). Please include your ABN or relevant form. Please indicate retail price, which should include GST, if applicable, and also a reserve price in the event your piece is chosen for auction.

The price of work is to be determined by the artist. Commission will be 30%. Proceeds after costs will be distributed equally between GTAF funding for 2011 and 'KIND' (Kids in Need).

Entry fees are payable via: Direct Debit, Cash, Cheque, payable at the time of submitting your entry form. Acknowledgment of payment will be made via email.

All work to be presented in a professional manner and ready to be hung, including strong hanging wire, framed if appropriate or stretched canvass work, stapled on the reverse. Work will be hung at the discretion of the organisers.
